#### Social Science and History


This term we will be covering the history of the Treaty of Waitangi. We will also explore the significance of the ships and waka that have travelled to New Zealand.

Formal <u>assessment</u> will begin in week three so that I can gain greater understanding around your child's learning needs and support them with goal setting in Maths, Reading and Writing.

#### <u>Numeracy</u>

-We will be working on instant recall of times tables and basic addition and subtraction facts.

- The children will be in ability based PRIME Maths groups to explore place value and strategies.

Goggles are not required, however I do recommend that they have a pair. It makes a difference.






#### Library Day is Wednesday
